

BUSINESS PROGRAM AT VENTURA COLLEGE

The Business Program provides a comprehensive curriculum that covers the fundamental principles of business, accounting, management, business law and communication within organizations. Critical thinking, social responsibility, and the global economy are emphasized.

Degrees, certificates and proficiency awards prepare students for a variety of jobs and industries:

- Students at the start of a career are prepared for entry-level positions and students with job experience are prepared for promotion and management positions
- Students seeking to start their own business are prepared with foundational information and knowledge required for entrepreneurship
- Students transferring to a baccalaureate program complete classes in a transfer-model curriculum (courses accepted by transferring institutions)
